Benjamin Leroux is a truly gifted winemaker! He became the GM and winemaker of Comte Armand at a tender age of only 26. He was responsible for the quality improvement we saw there and also for converting it to biodynamic. In 2007, he set up his own company Benjamin Leroux. He has long-term relationships with the growers/farmers that he works with. He pays them by the area of land instead of the quantity of fruit harvested. This allows him to dictate lower yields, ripeness, date of harvest, and so on. He only works with high quality growers who do not use chemical herbicides or pesticides. Most are organic or biodynamic. To him, quality of fruits and terroir are the key determining factors of the finished wines. One would expect much from his reds since he was from Comte Armand (Pommard) but his whites are stunning! Must try!

**Summary:** A top producer of the appellation, distinctive volcanic soil (with complex bluish rocks called Diorite) only on the Côte, medium to full bodied, great balance and delicious to drink. Vinify 7 different plots separately! They produce single vineyard wines! Traditional. Côte de Brouilly was first mentioned in a 12th century manuscript. In 14th century, the property was sold to a lawyer named **Thivin**, whose name the Chateau still bears. In 1877, during the middle of the phylloxera ravage, the ancestor of the current owner, Zaccharie Geoffray, a farmer from Villefranche sur Saone, bought the estate at an auction. Now, under the management of the **4th generation**, **Edouard** and his **wife Sonja**, both who studied winemaking and viticulture in Switzerland. The Chateau is located on the slopes beneath Mont Brouilly, surrounded by vines. The traditional aspect of the château goes hand-in-hand with impeccable winemaking skills and techniques; the process is laid out on various levels, and is designed to work by gravity, for the sake of the grapes and the wine. A beautiful vaulted cellar of blue stone houses the oak "foudres" (casks) in which the wine matures, and an older cellar beneath the château provides the perfect conditions for laying down the wine once bottled.
